- After inspection and approval by the DDA, reimbursement funds will be disbursed.



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DDA FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

OVERVIEW

The Three Oaks Downtown Development Authority (DDA), in partnership with the Village of Three Oaks (Village), has created a Downtown Façade Improvement Program that's intended to further the goals of the Downtown Development Plan to improve the overall business climate of the DDA district; improve the general appearance and visual amenities in the district; preserve buildings with unique features or character; and, provide assistance to small business owners.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Only buildings with retail, commercial, or professional uses consistent with downtown land uses are eligible.

Building owners or tenants are eligible. If a tenant applies for assistance, he/she must provide written proof that the owner has authorized proposed improvements.

Applicants will be required to complete an application form provided by the DDA.

Applicants are required to fund the project. At the completion of the project, the DDA will provide 50% of the total cost.

All required municipal/governmental permits must be obtained prior to the start of construction. The Village of Three Oaks 2050 Plan recognizes that the downtown establishes the character and image of the community and encourages the maintenance and enhancement of the downtown's historic building facades. Therefore, design improvements must be consistent or compatible with the historical significance and uniqueness of the Village's structures.

When possible, restoration to original appearance is encouraged, using authentic materials for faithful replication of missing parts.

Applicants are responsible for construction management and completion of all contracted work.

Property improvements must be completed within (90) days

Upon completion of the work, paid receipts must be presented to the DDA.

After inspection of property to insure that the completed work complies with the application submitted to and approved by the DDA, agreed 50% reimbursement will be made.

The DDA reserves the right to modify, return or deny any application for a grant.

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

Americans with Disabilities Act related building upgrades.

Repair to exterior facades, including front and rear entryways and outdoor seating areas. Side facades if they are visible to the public.

Restoration, repair or replacement of doors and windows.

Restoration, repair, or replacement of exterior walls, chimneys, or other architectural elements. Improvements to restore historical significance to buildings, including removal of after-installed facades which cover original architectural details.

Masonry repair, cleaning, or tuckpointing

Painting as part of a comprehensive façade improvement project.

Aesthetic improvements such as exterior lighting, or awnings with no text, images, etc.

INELIGIBLE PROJECTS

It is not the intent or purpose of to subsidize routine maintenance projects

Public buildings are not eligible

Costs incurred before final grant approval by DDA

Costs paid by applicant for merchandise or in-kind services

Labor paid to applicant, family members of applicant, or employee of applicant

Roof repair or replacement

Vinyl or Aluminum siding Mechanical

systems

Parking such as resurfacing, painting, or stripping of parking lot/spaces or creation

of new spaces

Signage or awning with lettering or images

Repair or creation of features not compatible with original architecture

Any interior work

Purchase of any furnishings or equipment

Residential or living space of any kind

PROJECT REVIEW AND SELECTION PROCESS

Façade Review Committee members and Village staff will work closely with property owners and tenants to determine initial eligibility under program guidelines. When the scope of work has been determined, the applicant will present the project to the Façade Review Committee. The Committee will meet as needed to provide input, make suggestions, and approve or deny individual projects. Funds will be awarded depending on the amount of funds available in the DDA Program at the time.

RIGHTS RESERVED

The Three Oaks DDA reserves the right to reject any and all applications. The specific program guidelines detailed herein are subject to revisions or amendments by the Façade Committee. The Three Oaks DDA may discontinue this program at any time.
